



2020 Special Assessment Level

Senior Citizens

- Must be 65 years old
- Income cannot exceed \$77,030.36

Disabled Veterans

- Can be any age
- Income cannot exceed \$77,030.36
- Must have a Service Connected Disability Rating of 50% or more by the U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs

Widows of Armed Forces Killed in Action /or Spouses of MIA or POW

- Can be any age
- Income cannot exceed \$77,030.36
- Must have verification that the spouse was a member of the Armed Forces of the United States or LA National Guard who was Killed in Action, or is currently Missing in Action, or is currently a Prisoner of War

Permanently Totally Disabled

- Can be any age
- Income cannot exceed \$77,030.36
- Must be Permanently and Totally Disabled as determined by a Final Non-appealable Judgement of Court or as Certified by a State Agency.

Note: The Veterans Affairs Office in the Courthouse Annex Building has agreed to provide us with a letter showing the % of Disability and verify KIA, MIA & POW status for the widows. Please visit the Veterans Affairs Office to request this letter.

Also, since there is an income limit for each category, it is necessary for all applicants to bring a copy of their most recently filed tax return or other proof of income for income verification.
